Location: Along SR 530 between MP 58.6 and 59.2 in Skagit County, WA. The town of Darrington lies approximately 9 miles south and the community of Rockport lies approximately 9 miles north, within section 5 of T 33 N, R 10 E, W.M

Project Description:

WSDOT is proposing a roadway embankment stabilization project along the Sauk River on SR 530. An activated side channel is diverting flow to the bank and causing erosion of the slope that supports SR 530. The proposed construction will begin in the summer of 2027 and may continue through summer 2028. Construction will consist of the installation of two timber reefs and seven dolotimber ELJs totaling 985 linear feet of additional bank stabilization. The structures are designed to collect and retain wood and will be vegetated with trees to offer increased long-term stability and shade for the Sauk River.

Required permits not included in application:

Floodplain and Land Disturbance Permits. State and federal permits/approvals.

SR 530 / Sauk River Corridor Study, Engineered Log Jams & Dolos Monitoring Report Executive Summary, Biological Assessment, Wetland and Stream Report, SEPA DNS.
