

LEGAL NOTICE

WSDOT, Spencer Beier, 1109 E Hickox Rd Mount Vernon, WA 98274, is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit.

The proposed project, SR 530/Sauk River Roadway Embankment - Stabilization, is located on SR 530 between MP 58.6 and 59.2 in Skagit County, Washington. The town of Darrington lies approximately 9 miles south and the community of Rockport lies approximately 9 miles north. The Project is within Section 5 of Township 33 North, Range 10 East, Willamette Meridian.

This project involves 0.54 acres of soil disturbance for Highway or Road construction activities.

The receiving water is Sauk River.

Any persons desiring to present their views to the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding this Application, or interested in Ecology's action on this Application, may notify Ecology in writing no later than 30 days of the last date of publication of this notice. Ecology reviews public comments and considers whether discharges from this project would cause a measurable change in receiving water quality, and, if so, whether the project is necessary and in the overriding public interest according to Tier II anti-degradation requirements under WAC 173-201A-320.
