

PUBLIC NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS TO CHANGE WATER RIGHTS

TAKE NOTICE:

That Norm Nelson Inc. of Burlington, WA on February 17, 2026 filed Water Right Application Nos. CG1-00454@2, CG1-GWC4386@2, CG1-GWC568@2, and CS1-20189@2. All of these applications propose seasonal changes to existing water right certificates for the 2026 irrigation season. The proposed changes are as follows:

CG1-00454@2

This application proposes to change groundwater certificate G1-00454CWRIS with a priority date of June 17, 1970. Certificated quantities are for seasonal use from an existing groundwater well in the amount of 250 gallons per minute (gpm) and 29 acre-feet per year (ac-ft/yr) for irrigation of 57 acres.

Proposal to add point of withdrawal: The authorized point of withdrawal is located within the E half of the SW quarter of Section 10, Township 35 N., Range 3 E., W.M., within Skagit County.

The proposed additional point of withdrawal is located within the NW quarter of the NE quarter of Section 17, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County.

Proposal to change place of use: The certificated place of use is 57 acres located within the NE quarter of the SW quarter and the south 396 feet of SE quarter of the NW quarter, all in Section 10, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed place of use is 33 acres located within the N half of the NE quarter of the SW quarter and the S half of SE quarter of the NW quarter, all in Section 10, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., 4 acres located within the SW quarter of the SE quarter of Section 7, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., and 20 acres located within the N half the SW quarter of the NE quarter of Section 18, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., all within Skagit County.

CG1-GWC4386@2

This application proposes to change groundwater certificate 4386 (G1-*06377C) with a priority date of July 13, 1962. Certificated quantities are for seasonal use from an existing groundwater well in the amount of 250 gpm and 140 ac-ft/yr for irrigation of 70 acres.

Proposal to add point of withdrawal: The authorized point of withdrawal is located within the SW quarter of the NW quarter of Section 22, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed additional point of withdrawal is located within the NW quarter of the NE quarter of Section 17, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County.

Proposal to change place of use: The certificated place of use is located within the SW quarter of the NW quarter and the SE quarter of the NW quarter of Section 22, Township 35 N Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed place of use is 42 acres located within the W half of the NW quarter of 22, Township 35 N, 3 E, W.M., and 28 acres located within the SW quarter of the SE quarter of Section 7, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., all within Skagit County

CG1-GWC568@2

This application proposes to change groundwater certificate 568 (G1-*01386C) with a priority date of February 28, 1950. Certificated quantities are for seasonal use from an existing groundwater well in the amount of 240 gpm and 150 ac-ft/yr for the irrigation of 100 acres.

Proposal to change points of withdrawal: The certificated point(s) of withdrawal is located within the N half of the S half of the SE quarter of Section 9, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed points of withdrawal are located within the SW quarter of the SW quarter of Section 9 Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., and the NW quarter of the NE quarter of Section 17, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., both within Skagit County.

Proposal to change place of use: The certificated place of use is located within the N half of the SE quarter and the N half of the SW quarter of the SE quarter of Section 9, Township 35N, Range 3, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed place of use is 62 acres within Government Lots 1, 4, and 5 of Section 8, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M, 36 acres within the NE of the SE of Section 7, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., and 2 acres located within the SW quarter of the SE quarter of Section 7, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., all within Skagit County.

CS1-20189@2

This application proposes to change surface water certificate S1-20189C with a priority date of June 26, 1972. Certificated quantities are for seasonal use from the Samish River in the amount of 0.45 cubic feet per second (cfs) and 86 acre-feet per year ac-ft/yr for purpose of irrigation of 45 acres.

Proposal to change points of diversion to points of withdrawal: The certificated points of diversion are located within the N half of the NW quarter and the W half of the W half of the NE quarter of Section 16, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed points of withdrawal are wells located within the NE quarter of the NE quarter of Section 16 and the NW quarter of the NE quarter of Section 17, both in Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County.

Proposal to change place of use: The certificated place of use is located within the N half of the NW quarter and the W half of the W half of the NE quarter in Section 16, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed place of use is 3 acres located within the SW quarter of the SE quarter of Section 7, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., 18 acres located within the SE quarter of the SW quarter of Section 9, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., and 24 acres located within the NE quarter of the NW quarter of Section 16, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., all within Skagit County.
