In connection with this proposal, a separate application has been submitted for the replacement of fifty-two (52) creosote-treated piles at the marina's D-dock with forty-two (42) 12-inch galvanized steel piling, the replacement of 11,505 square feet of concrete floating dock with 10,052 square feet of 50/50 concrete/fiberglass grated deck with 69% functional open space, and the reinstallation of electrical lines, and fire system utilities. Additionally, at third application has been submitted for the replacement of the marina's western timber breakwater and associated timber creosote piles and for the removal and replacement of timber creosote float piles at docks A, B, & C.

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PROPOSAL:

Description of Proposal: The applicant is requesting a shoreline letter of exemption and SEPA threshold determination for a maintenance dredging project to restore navigation depths and reduce the potential for grounding of vessels and docks at the facility during low tides. The project proposes to dredge approximately 28,500 cubic yards over a dredging area of 217,600 square feet. One-hundred-thirty-four (134) creosote piles will also be removed from the shoreline approximately 1/4 mile northeast of the project site for mitigation and habitat enhancement.
