NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **Board of Skagit County Commissioners** will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, June 29, 2026 at 1:00 pm, in the Skagit County Commissioners' Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, for the purpose of considering a resolution to amend the 2026 Budget for the following Funds in the approximate net amounts noted: General \$7,109,682; Emergency Management \$0; Substance Use Services \$0; Mental Health/Developmental Disability \$0; County Roads \$(873,116); Community Services \$250,000; Conservation Futures \$4,000,000; HB 2015 Community Safety & Support \$1,745,500; Lake Management District 1 \$39,900; Lake Management District 3 \$47,342; Lake Management District 4 \$0; Title III Projects Fund \$0; Homeless Housing & Assistance \$0; Capital Improvements \$430,320; Park Improvement \$0; Drainage Utility \$460,000; Equipment Rental & Revolving Fund \$0; Information Services \$0.
