Notice is hereby given that the City of Anacortes, as a participant in the federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, has prepared a draft 2026 Annual Action Plan in accordance with its 2023–2027 Consolidated Plan approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Annual Action Plan describes the proposed use of CDBG funds to address community development needs in a manner consistent with the Consolidated Plan and HUD National Objectives. The draft 2026 Annual Action Plan is available to view now on the City's website at <https://www.anacorteswa.gov/174>

under the 2026 Program Year. The Draft Action Plan is also available for public inspection on the City's public bulletin board and at the Mayor's Office in the Municipal Building. The 30-day public comment period is held between the dates of March 16, 2026, and will conclude on April 23, 2026. The City will consider the views of all citizens, public agencies, and other interested parties in preparing the final Annual Action Plan. A summary of comments received, together with responses, will be included in the final submission to HUD.

The Anacortes City Council will hold a Public Hearing at the Municipal Building, Council Chambers, 904 6th Street, Anacortes, Washington:

Public Hearing : April 27, 2026, at 6:00 p.m., for consideration of Public Comments followed by Council action for the 2026 CDBG Annual Action Plan. Funding allocations for the 2026 Program Year were estimated based on the City's 2025 CDBG allocation of \$108,427. Actual grant award amounts may vary from the plan, subject to the 2026 CDBG funding allocation to the City of Anacortes by HUD.
