The Mount Vernon City Council is seeking members to serve on one of two committees: one to advocate approval of, and one to advocate rejection of, the following proposition, scheduled for the November 3, 2026, general election:

**Mount Vernon
Transportation
Benefit District**

**Sales and Use Tax for
Transportation Improve-
ments**

Shall the Mount Vernon Transportation Benefit District (TBD) continue to impose the local sales and use tax in the amount of twotenths of one percent (0.2%) for a period of ten years to fund street improvement projects within the boundaries of the district, which are the same as the city limits of Mount Vernon?

Interested individuals should submit a letter of interest that includes their name, address, telephone number, and email address to the Mount Vernon Public Works Director, 1024 Cleveland Ave, Mount Vernon WA 98273. Individuals must also indicate their support of or opposition to the proposition and why they are interested in being a committee member. Letters of interest may be submitted via email to: MVEngineering@mountvernonwa.gov by fax to 360-336-6299, or by mail to the above street address. Letters of interest must be received by the City, regardless of the method of submittal, not later than 5:00 p.m., June 5, 2026.

No more than three persons may be appointed to each committee by the City Council. Each committee will be responsible for writing statements that will appear in the local voters' pamphlet (maximum of 250 words) related to the sales and use tax increase. The City Council anticipates appointing members during the June 10 or 24, 2026, city council meeting. Statements for the voters' pamphlet are due to the Skagit County Auditor by August 14, 2026.
