The Port of Anacortes (the "Port") hereby requests bid proposals for the **Pier 2 Fenders, Dolphins and Cap Rehab, Project #MRT-72** (the "Project"). The Port will only consider sealed bid proposals that i) are plainly marked **Pier 2 Fenders, Dolphins and Cap Rehab, Project #MRT-72**, ii) include the name and address of the Bidder, and iii) are timely received by **10:00 am, PDT on July 7, 2026** at:

Bids will be opened and recorded at that time. The Project generally involves furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary for the completion of Pier 2 Fenders, Dolphins and Cap Rehab Project in Anacortes, Washington as detailed in the project drawings and specifications. The Project generally consists of, but is not limited to: implementation of temporary site controls, traffic/pedestrian controls, marine environmental/water quality controls, and temporary erosion and sediment controls; marine fenders and frame repairs; rub strip and rub boards replacement; mooring cleats repairs; pier ladders replacement; marine structure pile wraps and anodes installation; and structural concrete pile cap rehabilitation and other appurtenances as more fully defined in the Contract Documents (the "Work"). The Work is divided into a Base Bid and three Bid Additive Alternates as more fully defined in the Contract Documents.
