



NOTICE of APPLICATION with SEPA

Island County has reviewed the proposed project for probable adverse environmental impacts and expects to issue a determination of non-significance (DNS). The optional DNS process established by WAC 197-11-355 is being used. **The public comment period as described below may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the following proposal.** **File:** 537/25 SHE-II, **Applicant:** BRUTUS MAINTENANCE ASSN, **Location:** 3455 TIMOTHY WAY, CAMANO ISLAND, WA 98282 (S6192-00-0000A-0) **Proposal:** The proposal replaces 50% of the existing 416-linear-foot timber pile bulkhead within the same footprint using a soldier pile bulkhead with tie-backs. The design includes weep holes, replacement of the outfall drainage pipe with a dispersion tee, and integrated stairs extending from the existing footpath to provide beach access. **Staff Contact:** Austin Hoofnagle a.hoofnagle@islandcountywa.gov.
