Any person having a claim
against the decedent
must, before the time the
claim would be barred by
any otherwise applicable
statute of limitations, pres-
ent the claim in the man-
ner as provided in RCW
11.40.070 by serving on or
mailing to the co-personal
representatives or the at-
torney of the co-person-
al representatives at the
address stated below a
copy of the claim and fil-
ing the original of the claim
with the court in which the
probate proceedings were
commenced. The claim
must be presented with-
in the later of: (1) 30 days
after the attorney served
or mailed the notice to the
creditor as provided under
RCW 11.40.020(1)(c); or
(2) four months after the
date of first publication
of the notice. If the claim
is not presented within
this time frame, the claim
is forever barred, except
as otherwise provided in
RCW 11.40.051 and RCW
11.40.060. This bar is ef-
fective as to claims against
both the decedent’s pro-
bate and non-probate as-
sets.
