enter an Order of Default  
against you permanent-  
ly terminating all of your  
rights to the above-named  
child. The Court may, with-  
out further notice to you,  
enter an Order relinquish-  
ing the child to the Peti-  
tioner, terminating your  
parent/child relationship  
and approving or provid-  
ing for the adoption of the  
above-named child.

child's mother is Kristina

Your failure to appear at

has the right to be rep-  
resented by an attorney,  
and an attorney will be  
appointed for an indigent  
person who requests an  
attorney. You are further  
notified that you have a  
right to file under Chapter  
26.26 RCW a claim for pa-  
ternity.

You are further notified  
that your failure to file a  
claim of paternity within 20  
days of the date of service  
of this notice and Sum-  
mons upon you or your  
failure to respond to the  
Petitioner within 20 days  
of the date of the service  
of Summons and Notice  
upon you, is grounds to  
terminate your parent/  
child relationship with re-  
spect to the child. One  
method of filing your re-  
sponse is serving a copy  
of the petitioner by send-  
ing the response by Certi-  
fied Mail with Return Re-  
ceipt Requested.
