

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF
APPLICATION TO
CHANGE A
WATER RIGHT**

TAKE NOTICE:

That Skagit Valley Farm, LLC of Burlington, WA filed Water Right Applications for Change Nos.)

CG1-GWC1057 (Filed April 1, 2026) and CG1-GWC1429 (Filed April 2, 2026). Both of these applications propose seasonal changes to portions of existing water right certificates for the 2026 irrigation season.

Together, Groundwater Certificates 1057 and 1459 authorize the water right holder to withdraw up to 800 gpm, 300 afy, for the purposes of irrigating 150 acres. Skagit Valley Farm is proposing to seasonally transfer 600 gpm, 278.5 afy, and 134.5 acres away from the certificated point of withdrawal and place of use. The remaining quantities will remain unchanged with the original water right holder.

Summaries of each groundwater certificate are as follows:

CG1-GWC1057

This application proposes to change groundwater certificate 1057 (G1-01129S) with a priority date of July 1, 1939. Certificated quantities are for seasonal use from an existing groundwater well in the amount of 400 gpm and 300 ac-ft/yr for irrigation. The original place of use is about 150 acres in size.

CG1-GWC1429

This application proposes to change groundwater certificate 1429 (G1-02489C) with a priority date of May 1, 1952. Certificated quantities are for seasonal use from an existing groundwater well in the amount of 400 gpm and 0 acre-feet/year for irrigation of 150 acres.

The spatial attributes of both existing groundwater certificates are identical, as are the following proposed location changes:

Proposal to add points of withdrawal: The certificated point of withdrawal for both certificates is within the NE quarter of Section 24, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed additional points of withdrawal are located within the NW quarter of the NE quarter of Section 23 Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., and the NW quarter of the NE quarter of Section 36, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., both within Skagit County.

Proposal to change portion of place of use: The certificated place of use for both certificates is within the NE quarter of Section 24, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., within Skagit County. The proposed place of use is 54.5 acres located within the NE quarter of Section 23, and 80 acres within the SE quarter of the NW quarter and the SW quarter of the NE quarter of Section 36, Township 35 N, Range 3 E, W.M., all within Skagit County.
