INVITATION FOR BIDS**

The Bayshore Water System (BWS) will receive bids for construction of a water line replacement project. The project in general will be to replace the distribution system and service meter assemblies.

Scope of work elements include:

- Install approximately 200 lineal feet of 2" HDPE pipe and approximately 2,500 lineal feet of 4" HDPE piping. Water main costs including valves, blow offs, air release valves, vaults, and other appurtenances as needed.

- Connect existing services to the new main lines. Replace approximately 36 service meter assemblies and install approximately 4 future water service assemblies with appurtenances as needed.

- Install an auxiliary inlet on the existing storage tank and an outlet line with backflow prevention in the existing pumphouse for emergency purposes.

A mandatory bid walk through of the proposed project will take place at 2:00 PM on Friday, July 10th, 2026. The bid walk will begin at the pump house located at 831 Anna Drive, Camano Island, WA 98282. Call Coffman at 360-707-5656 to confirm in case of inclement weather. Sealed bids will be received at the offices of Coffman prior to 2:00 PM on Friday, July 24th, 2026, where bids will be opened and publicly read. All bids not received prior to the time and date set forth above will not be accepted for consideration. It is anticipated that the work can begin 7 days after a contract is signed is to be completed or on before December 12th, 2026.

The contractor must be licensed, bonded, and insured in the State of Washington and must have satisfactorily completed a minimum of two similar drinking water pipeline replacement projects in the past five years.

**Bid Security:** A certified or bank cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid amount, payable to the Bayshore Water System, or bid bond executed by a licensed bonding company is required with each bid.

**Rejection of Bids:** the BWS specifically reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive minor informalities or irregularities.

The BWS is an Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action Employer. Small, Minority- and Women-Owned Businesses are encouraged to submit bids. All work performed on the project will be subject to the higher of the prevailing state or federal wage rates.

This project is funded through the Washington State Drinking Water State Revolving Fund program. DWSRF requirements and provisions must be met by general contractors and all subcontractors.

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
