



ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS City Shops Storage Building

Sealed bid proposals will be received by the City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284 until **10:00 a.m., February 11, 2025**, at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read.

The improvement consists of: Construction of grading and site work, parking lot, paving, exterior lighting, sidewalks, temporary erosion control, permanent and temporary stormwater detention and treatment, signage, landscaping, plantings, seeding, restoration, utilities (power, water, sewer, communications), vehicle storage structures and foundations and all other work necessary to complete the improvements shown on the plans or described in the specifications to provide for a vehicle storage building.

This project is subject to all applicable Prevailing Wage statutes and regulations.

All work shall be done in accordance with the Special Provisions of the Bid Documents, the 2024 WS-DOT Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction, including the amendments thereto, City Standards and other referenced documents.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sedro-Woolley.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting is scheduled for January 28, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. at Public Works Central Shop, 501 Alexander Rd., Sedro-Woolley.
