NOTICE OF RECOUNT

Island County has two recounts

The certified final results from the November 8, 2022 General Election shows two races within mandatory recount range.

RCW 29A.64.021 requires that a hand recount be conducted when a race that is not statewide has a difference of fewer than 150 votes and also less than a 0.25% difference between the votes counted for the two candidates.

The Island County Assessor race has a certified final count of 11 votes and less than 0.25% apart.

The RCW also requires that a machine recount be conducted when a race that is not statewide has a difference of fewer than 2,000 votes and also less than a 0.50% difference between the votes counted for the two candidates.

The Legislative District #10, Position 1 race will have a final count of fewer than 2,000 votes and less than 0.50% apart.

The hand recount for the Island County Assessor race will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, December 5th at the Elections Office and will take place each day during office hours. The recount is expected to be completed and certified by the Canvassing Board at their meeting on Friday, December 9th at 4:00 p.m.

The machine recount for the 10th Legislative District, Position 1 race will take place in the Elections Office the week of December 12th, according to a schedule to be determined by the Secretary of State's Office.

As with all Elections processes, observers are welcome.
