WAITLIST OPENING FOR Housing Choice Voucher Program (Section 8) and City of Tucson-Owned Housing

The City of Tucson will be accepting pre-applications for the City of Tucson and Pima County Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Programs and City of Tucson-Owned Housing beginning January 3, 2023, and will remain open. However, all applications received as of January 24, 2023, will go through the first lottery process and will be randomly selected and placed on the waitlist based on the lottery selection. A monthly lottery will be done every month thereafter for placement on the waitlist. The City reserves the right to close the waitlist should this be determined necessary at a later date.

Overview:

- Persons can apply online which is available in English, Spanish, Arabic and Swahili, Chinese, Korean and Vietnamese.
- Assistance will be provided to anyone who requests help. For example, alternate formats of the pre-application, such as paper applications, large print, in braille, translation/interpreting services, or other alternate needs are available for those who need it. See Page 3 for more information on how to submit a request.
- There are several waitlists available for preapplication:
 - City of Tucson and Pima County Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8)
 - City of Tucson-Owned Affordable Housing. It includes apartments and single-family units. Locations can be found on Page 4.
- There is no need to rush to submit a pre-application because the primary way to apply will be online. Pre-Applications can be received online and the first round of the lottery selection will take place after January 24, 2023 and will be done monthly thereafter.
- Applicants will not be required to provide social security numbers.
- Only one application may be submitted per household. Duplicate applications will be removed.
- Applicants can apply for all or specific waitlists, as desired. Be aware that some locations have different requirements such as household size, which the online application portal will determine.

How to Apply Online

- Pre-applications will be accepted starting 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, Arizona Time and ongoing.
- All completed pre-applications will receive a Confirmation Number. Be sure to save this number. Applicants should both write it down and email it to yourself at the end of the pre-application.
- All applications received as of January 24, 2023, will go through the first lottery process and will be randomly selected and placed on the waitlist based on the lottery selection. A monthly lottery will be done every month thereafter for placement on the waitlist. Anyone who applies will have equal access to housing based on your local preference.

Staff will respond to all requests within 5 business days. The lottery will occur after all requests are completed.

What Does a Lottery Mean?

The City of Tucson will conduct an electronic lottery after January 24th. Each application is assigned a number and a computer program randomly selects the lottery winners and applicants will be placed in the order their number is selected.

When the City of Tucson conducts a lottery, all applications in the lottery pool have an equal chance of being selected. The timing of when application is submitted will not help or hurt your odds of being selected in a lottery.

Applicants selected in the lottery are added to the City of Tucson waitlist. As funding is available, applicants will be selected from the waitlist and will have to complete a full application and go through the eligibility process. It is unknown how long it will be before an applicant is asked to complete the full application. If there are any changes to the applicant's address, email or phone number, the applicant must notify the City of Tucson. Information on how to report changes will be provided to each applicant after pre-application is received.

What are local preferences?

PHAs are permitted to establish local preferences, and to give priority to serving families that meet those criteria. Each program has its own preferences as listed below:

- Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Program: Residency Preference – 1 Point – Applicant Selected

The PHA will provide 1-point residency preference to address the housing needs of families living or working/hired to work in the City of Tucson and/or Pima County, the PHA will establish a preference for “resident” families, where the applicant family is:

- A family whose head of household, spouse, co-head or sole member is/are employed in the City of Tucson or Pima County or has accepted employment in the City of Tucson or Pima County.
- City-Owned Public Housing Program - Working Preference – 1 Point – Applicant Selected

In order to bring higher income families into public housing, the PHA will establish a preference for “working” families, where the head, spouse, co-head, or sole member is employed at least 20 hours per week. As required by HUD, families where the head and spouse, or sole member is a person aged 62 or older, or is a person with disabilities, will also be given the benefit of the working preference,

- City-Owned Public Housing Program - Residency Preference – 1 Point – Applicant Selected

In order to address the housing needs of families living or working/hired to work in the City of Tucson and/or Pima County, the PHA will establish a preference for “resident” families, where the applicant family is:

A permanent resident of the City of Tucson or Pima County; or

A family whose head of household, spouse, co-head or sole member is/are employed in the City of Tucson or Pima County or has accepted employment in the City of Tucson or Pima County.
