The Tucson Bicycle Classic Needs More Volunteers. We need your help!

The 35th annual Tucson Bicycle Classic starts on March 3rd. Over 90 great volunteers have signed up so far but we still need more volunteers to make this race as safe as possible. Without volunteers, bicycle races like the Tucson Bicycle Classic simply cannot happen. Here's what we need (and we <u>especially</u> need course marshals):

In Sahuarita on Saturday, March 4th - Morning and Afternoon shifts needed

Corner marshals (like crossing guards)

Comm cars drivers - you'll be driving a race official in a Jim Click loaner vehicle

Lead vehicles – you'll be driving your vehicle at the head of the racers

Wheel car drivers – you'll be driving your vehicles behind the racers with spare wheels for racers who get a flat tire

Other volunteers - eg, wheel tent manager, etc.

In Oro Valley on Sunday, March 5th - Morning and Afternoon shifts needed

Corner marshals

Comm car drivers

Lead vehicles

Other volunteers – eg, rider check-in, etc

If you are racing in the TBC – great! If you are bringing a friend or family member to the race, please ask them to take a volunteer shift.

There will be online training for volunteers on Monday, Feb. 27th to help go over where to park, what to bring and the responsibilities of your position.
