



# PathStone Corporation Receives \$1.1 Million Grant

## *- Local Homeowners May Qualify For Weatherization Assistance -*

ROCHESTER, NY (July 24, 2017) - On Tuesday, July 11th, PathStone Corporation was awarded a grant for \$1.1 million in funding for its Weatherization Assistance Program. This no-cost program, funded by NYS Housing and Community Renewal, helps eligible homeowners in suburban Monroe County and focuses on households with senior citizens, persons with disabilities and households with children.

The program's professionally trained crews use computerized energy audits and advanced diagnostic equipment to identify energy-saving strategies in single-family, multi-family and mobile homes. Cost-effective weatherization measures and those measures that are essential for health and safety are then performed at no cost for eligible households. A few of the many services can include insulation, heating and air sealing to reduce drafts. Since 1976, more than seven million households nationwide have experienced energy efficient, financial, health and safety gains as a result of weatherization measures.
