AFFIDAVIT AND ORDER
RE: PROBABLE CAUSE

The undersigned, being duly sworn, states as follows:

That I am the officer who arrested the Defendant, **STEVEN DARRELL DUBOIS**, for the charge(s) of, **Theft - Felony & Obstructing a Police Officer** and that I believe there is probable cause to charge said Defendant with said charges because:

- On 4/8/14 at 1137 hours I was dispatched to Wayne Miller's coin shop for a theft of coins that had just occurred.
- During the investigation I learned that a box containing 500, 1 oz silver rounds, valued at \$11,000.00 had been stolen.
- I viewed the store surveillance video and observed two male individuals enter the store. One appeared to distract the clerk and the other subject took the box of coins.
- The clerk ran after the suspects and observed them leave in a black mini van. The clerk obtained a partial license plate number
- Photos of the two suspects were obtained from the video footage and were emailed to officers and jail staff for identification. A short time later several people responded and positively identified the two subjects as Steven Dubois and his brother, William Lawrence.
- While checking their last known address officers located a black mini van parked in the alley behind the residence. The plate number was very similar to the number provided by the witness.
- The van was parked near the residence of Steven Dubois's wife, Teresa Norris.
- Steven arrived a short time later. Officers attempted to contact him but Steven ran from the officers. A perimeter was set up and a search was conducted. After about 40 minutes Steve was located and again he ran from officers. He was then taken into custody.
- I met with Steve's wife, Teresa Norris. During my interview she told me that Steve came home and she left with him while he got some car parts. Teresa said that Steve told her that he and William had stolen a box of coins from Wayne Miller's Coin shop. Teresa said Steven would not tell her where he put the coins.
- Steven was interviewed and admitted to stealing the coins.
