Saints head to Rocky in search of first road win

ROAD TESTED: Three storylines as Carroll College football travels to Rocky Mountain

Tillie Nelson said it best. "On the road again; I just can't wait to get on the road again." Well, maybe not for Carroll College football team.

The Saints have lost both road games this season.

A trip to Billings this weekend to play Rocky Mountain College starts a span of four weeks where three of them will be traveling away from Nelson Stadium.

Carroll hasn't had a winning season in five years and will need to win three out of the next four to accomplish that goal.

As the Saints get comfortable on their charter bus, here are three storylines to keep track of leading up to the game.

1. Overcoming road woes

Carroll has not had much success on the road as of late.

Since its 10-win 2014 season, the Saints have struggled away from Nelson Stadium, winning just 35 percent of its games.

The team has also felt the sting on the road so far this season with losses at both Montana Western to open the year and at Southern Oregon. The Saints led in both games before giving up the lead and the game late.

Only last year did Carroll have a winning record on the road, but one of those wins came from Rocky Mountain's forfeit because it had played academically ineligible players.

The good news is that Herb Klindt Field has been kind to the Saints, as they have won three out of the last five games there.

Carroll is a young group that has had to mature quickly. Claiming its first win on Saturday would do wonders for this team's confidence.

2. A confident running game

Carroll struggled running the ball two weeks ago against the College

Its 138 yards were the least since a senior day loss to Eastern Oregon last year.

That all changed against Montana Western.

Freshman Matthew Burgess ran for 183 yards and two touchdowns, while senior Major Ali ran for 107 yards and a touchdown. Even quarterback Devan Bridgewater got into the action with a 26-yard run.

Rocky Mountain enters the game ranked last in the Frontier Conference in rushing yards allowed per game.

Can Carroll take advantage of that?

3. New defense working

There were some thoughts on how Carroll's defense was going to do when it switched from the 3-4 scheme to a 4-3 scheme.

Thus far, the change hasn't really hurt.

Carroll ranks fourth in total defense and scoring defense and second in run defense, pretty comparable to last season.

The Saints pass defense is near the bottom of the Frontier Conference, giving up 281.5 passing yards per game, but is tied for third in the conference, picking off eight passes. That has to count for something, right?

Rocky Mountain settled on its quarterback and the Saints shut down the passing attack during the last meeting.

Can they do it again?
