### JACK CREEK PRESERVE FOUNDATION OUTDOOR SKILLS CAMPS

#### July 20-23 and August 3-6

We host two summer camps for youth ages 11–16 to learn a variety of outdoor skills in a wilderness setting. The camps are four days and three nights and include classes like archery, fly fishing, elk ecology, wildlife tracking, water ecology, mapping and orienteering, outdoor cooking, photography, shel-




