

I was fortunate to have an outstanding Staff and Board, and together we worked to bring value to our local business community.

Our members told us that Legislation, Economic Impact, and Professional and Leadership Development were priorities for the Chamber in 2017. Here are a few of the highlights and successes that "made the Chamber matter more" for business this year:

Successful lobbying effort at the 2017 Montana Legislature

- With the stellar work of Lobbyist Ronda Wiggers, the chamber lobbied on over 100 bills at this year's session. Our pro-business work makes a difference for all of Helena's businesses.

Professional Development Wisdom Wednesdays –

The Chamber provided free opportunities for businesses and their employees to learn from some excellent presenters, including: Ray Zinn- longest running Silicon Valley CEO, and author of Tough Things First; Jason Davis/Tim Meldrum – SMA Architects – Making Your Business Shine From Within; Sheriff Leo Dutton – L&C County Sheriff – Live Shooter Do's and Don'ts; and Jaime Sorenes - St. Peter's Hospital – Importance of a Healthy Team.

• Annual Banquet - Over 700 members of the local business community came together to

network and celebrate our business community. Instead of our silent auction, we changed things up to auction "chair" packages sponsored by local businesses.

- Leadership Development Leadership Helena This marks the 34th year of the Chamber's outstanding program with 34 professionals completing the ninemonth program, which includes leadership training, as well as opportunities to meet and hear from local business and government leaders.
- Economic Impact Another successful SWISH Tournament with 120-130 teams was held in 2017. The SWISH is the oldest youth basketball tournament in Montana, and has an annual impact to the local economy of \$750,000 to \$1 million.
- Publications that make a difference for Helena Vacation/ Relocation Guide (25,000 copies), Helena Street Map (10,000 copies), Business 2 Business Connection Magazines (2X a year 5000 copies), Trends Report data guide (2500 copies), Tear-off maps (2500), and many information sources via our website, e-blasts, and more.

The Helena Area Chamber had a very successful year in 2017! Thank you to all who work for and support our local businesses.

- Strengthening ties with City and County Government: The Chamber members offer a large voice in the City and County Government policies and we will work with locally elected officials to cultivate probusiness and business responsible policies for the Helena area communities.



The Radisson Colonial Hotel is an icon of the Helena Community that was built in 1971. It has had new owners since 2012 and boasts some amazing stats that make it an award winning business. They host 2200 conferences and events per year and recently invested millions to update and make it very upscale. The hotel employs more than 100 people and services 150 quest rooms along with 18,000 square feet of flexible event space, which is the most in Helena with 15 conference rooms.

The Radisson also stands out as an employer by providing lunch/dinner to all employees during their shift and have parties for staff two times a year. But their generosity doesn't stop there, as they host twice a year the Lost and Foundation, an organization that raises money for needs in the community, they participate in Festival of the Trees, they host a disadvantaged family for Christmas including presents, donate to the Lewis and Clark Humane Society and participate in food drives.

Their recent renovation left only the grand staircase as an original feature, with renovations being done by local businesses.

Terry Gauthier owns two businesses and employs 90-100 people and is a big supporter of local events and organizations such as 4-H, Big Brothers Big Sisters, Intermountain, Lewis and Clark Humane Society, Prickly Pear Land Trust, Boy Scouts, YWCA, NAMI, Helena Food Share, Governor's Cup, SWISH Tournament, Toys for Tots and Helena Education Foundation. He is a former Marine with 22 years of service. As a retirement option, he and his wife bought their businesses in Helena and made this their home. Because it is important to him that his employees earn a livable wage, he was the first of his industry to offer a starting wages of \$12-\$13 per hour to address that and help with workforce shortages experienced in Helena. A couple of years ago, this businessman stepped up to give business a voice in the Montana legislature and was successful in becoming a Senator for the Helena area.

peers from across the state.


For the local economy, those spending their money at local hotels, restaurants and stores produce an estimated economic impact of close to \$1 million.







Boss of the Year Sara Medley takes personal interest in her staff

Sara Medley was taking her staff on a walking meeting Monday morning when an employee suggested they take a detour through the basement to move a bookcase. Instead, Medley, CEO of Mountain-Pacific Quality Health, was surprised by dozens of her employees and representatives of the Helena Area Chamber of Commerce, who were waiting to present her with the 2017 Boss of the Year Award. Medley said it couldn't have been more unexpected.

Lewis and Clark Brewing Co. unveils completed expansion

August 6, 2017

Lewis & Clark Brewing Company celebrated the completion of a \$9 million expansion project with a ribbon cutting ceremony by Gov. Steve Bullock and Mayor Jim Smith on Friday.

Bullock said the 15-month expansion project is just one example of healthy entrepreneurship in the state. There are 68 breweries in Montana providing more than 700 jobs, which results in approximately \$100 million in economic output, he said.

"It's an exciting time across Montana," he said. "This is an incredible success story."

The new brewery, which is adjacent to the existing location, will triple production with advanced technology. Owner Max Pigman said he'd been looking for a way to expand for several years, but available property would have put him in the Helena Valley or Montana City. When he got the chance to buy adjacent property and

petition the city for the sale of part of Dodge Street, the project became a reality.

"We really wanted to stay in our home neighborhood," he

At the old brewery, Lewis and Clark could fill 25 cans per minute. New equipment allows them to fill 250 cans. The technology will also give cans an extra six weeks of shelf life.

Pigman said they built the new space with the option for even more future expansion.

"We don't have to do anything but buy a tank and brew to increase production," he

The new space will be used to produce core products such as Prickly Pear Pale Ale, which will now be available in a 12 pack, while the old space will brew beers called "The Expedition Series." Pigman said customers will have more access to seasonals, barrel aged beers and sours.

"There's not any other hot springs in majority of the space. town," Chris Johnson said. "From that perspective it's real easy to see that this facility needed to take another direction. It didn't survive as an athletic club." Now customers can pay a day-use fee

for any of the pools, sauna and steam room and the fitness center. The new taproom has a garage door that opens up into the pool area to allow people to easily go back and forth to order food and drinks. Since all beer and wine is served in plastic cups, people are allowed

to have drinks while they're in the pool. The Springs Taproom and Grill menu includes pizza, burgers and other bar food. There are 19 beers on tap with three rotating. People can also choose from

The interior of the restaurant has tathree tap wines. bles made from the floor of the racquetball court, reclaimed wood, old railroad tracks and ties and photos of the historic Hotel Broadwater and Natatorium.

In his first three months as CEO, Wade Johnson has worked diligently to get a feel for the staff and providers of St. Peter's as well as the overall environment of the organization. Every day, he makes time to get on the front line of care, visiting with laundry workers and facility engineers to physicians and nurses. He has also honed a listening ear to gain awareness of current issues within the community, and pairs it with his knowledge of the impending changes in the health care industry.

An additional six physicians have been added to these boards, a move Johnson believes will lead to better outcomes for patients while building a stronger operational foundation to attract top medical talent.
