If using BLOX Total CMS advertising code and your ads are in a location other than the appliance, you must mount that location. Add these shares to your login items so they automatically mount.

» Mac in Mixed Environment

Mixed environments have two tcms data shares. One labeled tcms data and the other mac tcms data.
