

# 1-Pager — on Standalone Photo Package —

*Setting up a standalone photo package with more than one photo.*

## » OVERVIEW

*The concept is that we want the captions edited for each photo separately so they go online edited, but we need a print only version for print.*

## » THE PROCESS

- Step 1**  
Place the first photo onto an Adobe InDesign page.
- Step 2**  
Place the second photo onto the same page and continue the process for each additional photo.
- Step 3**  
Move all the cutline, or caption, frames onto the pasteboard, on the side of the page.
- Step 4**  
Delete all the standalone headline frames except for the main photo that you placed first.
- Step 5**  
Take the main photo's headline

- frame and move it where desired (if needed) and format it as desired.
- Step 6**  
Create a new text frame for the combined caption.
- Step 7**  
Set the element type for the combined caption to "caption\_jump."
- Step 8**  
Add the file reference of the main photo to the new combined caption frame.
- Step 9**  
Create the assignment using the BLOX Total CMS menu option.

## NOTES

**SLUGS:** Make sure each photo gets a unique slug. Using suffix of p01, p02, p03, etc. is a great addition to the slugs.

**COLLECTION:** If these photos are going to be in a collection, that can be setup in BLOX Total CMS in the browser interface before or after the print product is produced.

**FUTURE UPDATE:** At some point BLOX Total CMS for Adobe InDesign will support placing a collection to get all the images at once. That is probably a year away. So the photos must be brought onto the page all at once. Having a similar slug will help when this feature is added, so plan accordingly.
