

2-Pager — on Ruleset Cache

Resetting browser cache to fix hidden dialog boxes

Ruleset settings, including where the dialog boxes open on the screen, are stored in a browser

cookie. The cookie mostly likely will be the url of your BLOX Total CMS appliance.

» CHROME

Step 1

Click the Customize button.



Step 2

Select Settings.

Step 3

Click the Show Advanced Settings link.

Step 4

Under Privacy, click Content Settings.

Step 5

Click All Cookies and Site Data.

Step 6

Either click Remove All to remove all the cookies, or mouse over the cookie you would like to delete and select the Delete (X) to the right.

Step 7

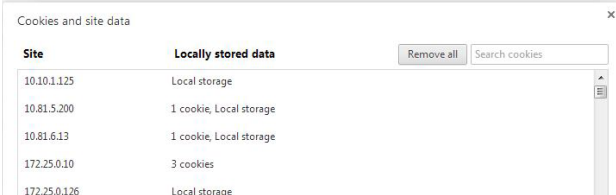
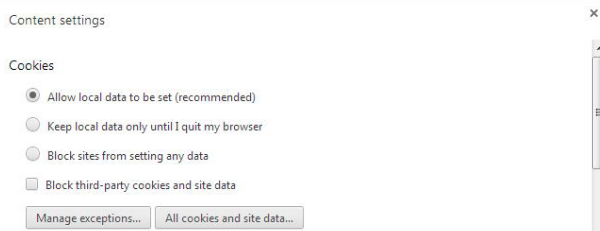

Step 1

Click the orange Settings button or the Tools drop-down menu. On a Mac, choose the Firefox menu and select Preferences.

Step 2

Mouse over Options and select Options from the menu that pulls out.

Step 3

Click the Privacy tab.

Step 4

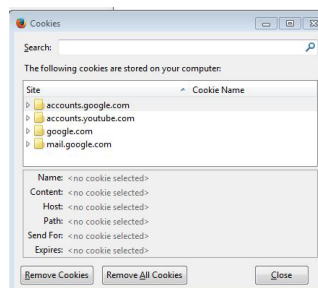
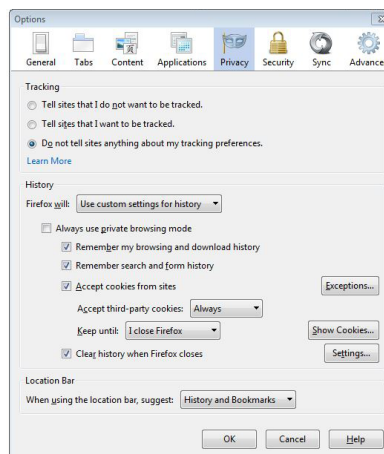
Select Show Cookies.

Step 5

Either click Remove All Cookies to remove all the cookies, or find the cookie you would like to delete and click the Remove Cookies button.

Step 6

Click Close.

» **INTERNET EXPLORER**

To delete selected cookies.

Step 1

Click the Tools drop-down menu or select the gear icon at the upper-right corner of the window.

Step 2

Select Internet Options.

Step 3

In the General tab, under the Browsing History section, click Settings.

Step 4

Select View Filles.

Step 5

Find and select the cookies you would like to delete and press the delete key on your keyboard.

Step 6

Click OK.

To delete all cookies.

Step 1

Click the Tools drop-down menu or select the gear icon at the upper-right corner of the window.

Step 2

Select Internet Options.

Step 3

In the General tab, under the Browsing History section, click Delete.

Step 4

Select the Cookies and Website Data option.

Step 5

Click the Delete button.

Step 6

Click OK.

» **SAFARI**

Step 1

Click the Safari menu.

Step 2

Select Preferences.

Step 3

Click Privacy.

Step 4

Select Details.

Step 5

Select the cookies you want to delete and click Remove, or select Remove All.

Step 6

Click Done.
