Here are the notes from our meeting today.

Opened the meeting at 10:00am with introductions. Gerry then reviewed the Historical evaluation of the Staley Pump House done be "Fever River Consultants". We discussed that in the report and all the information Gerry has been able to find, it looks like reduced usage of the Hall and Kitchen on the top floor of the Pump House started around the time of WWII with many of the men gone for a few years, and then the HW 36 bridge project in 1955 taking the parking lot, and hence making it unsafe to enter the building.

We discussed the On-Water demolition via barges and the need for a "spoils" area on the shore of S. Lake Shore Drive. Following actions were agreed to:

- 1. Tate & Lyle will put together a map of how we would use the area on S. Lake Shore Drive and still allow access for the Sanitary District to the Lake Shore Lift Station. We will present this to Paul and Keith to review with the sanitary folks, Jake will look at this.
- 2. Tate & Lyle requested the City write a letter for the Corps of Engineers expressing their support in the Demolition of the Staley Pump House. Keith A. agreed to work on this, Thanks Keith!
- 3. We also agreed to have our contractor put up warning buoys up to keep pedestrian boats out of the demolition area.
- 4. Jake will ask the Railroad to also write a letter supporting the demolition of the pump house.
