

The charge that was made against Lt. Antonio Brown has been adjudicated by an administrative judge and that judge has rendered an opinion in his favor. . His opinion was adopted by a three-member panel of the Human Rights Commission as the opinion of the Commission and no appeal was taken from that decision so the complaint against him is concluded. The Macon County Sheriff's Office was named in a separate case, solely based upon the fact that the office is the employer of Lt. Brown and it did not contain any different allegations. Unfortunately the case is still pending due to backlog at the Commission and no official ruling has been made regarding the Macon County Sheriff's Office. Due to the pending status of this case, I will not be making any further statement.
