





I'm still trying to sort out on all what happened but what I have gathered so far is the following:

Today was a half day for the schools and MHS got out at 11:30. During the last 45 mins or so of school there was an all school assembly in the gym. During the assembly in the upper west balcony area (where the sit), got to fighting, other then jumped in. Students from around the fight, including the seats on the floor, then went running up to watch the fight. During this time 2 other fights about break out where students had to be restrained by teachers.

The gym is then released where another fight breaks out in the Main Hallway between . Other student are trying to jump in and are being held back by teachers. While trying to break up this fight I was knocked to the ground and stampled on.

While this fight started to calm down and everyone was separated, another fight between then almost breaks out, outside the school where students had to be taken to the ground to be restrained by teachers.

I was also advised that there were possibly 2 or 3 other incidents at this time, but this is yet to be confirmed. Videos will be watched and saved during school tomorrow while everything gets straightened out.

I was told that at least 3 teachers were injured trying to break up fights during different times.

I have talked with the Principal and everyone involved, either fighting or trying to fight, will try to be identified and arrested. My report number is DR18-001279.

WAND must have been on the scanner because they were quick to respond. I think the school district gave them a generic statement and I'm sure it will be on the news tonight.

If anything changes I will let you know.

Same actions taken to contain the situation.

"It saddens me when negative things happen in our Decatur Public Schools, it's the schools that get the bad rep. DPS61 has some of the best educators, administrators, etc. How do I know?
