The Arthur Christian girls' basketball team defeated the number two seed Unity Christian (NC), 60 - 35, to finish third in the NACA Division 5 Christian School National Tournament in Dayton, TN.

ACS ended their season with a 27 - 12 overall record. Unity Christian fell to 21 - 3.

Alexa Franklin had a game high 24 points, on 9 of 13 shooting from the field and 6 of 7 from the free throw line. She also grabbed 6 rebounds, dished out 4 assists, and had 3 steals.

Chloe Tiarks contributed 8 points and 6 assists.

Lyla Kauffman hit two three pointers on her way to 8 points, 4 rebounds, and 3 steals.

Lindsey Mast contributed 5 points, 4 rebounds, 4 steals, and 3 assists.

All four of those girls are seniors.

Franklin also added two more school records to her list of marks already broken. She set a new standard for points per game in a season with 23.2 points and two-point shooting percentage in a season with 56.3%. The previous marks were 18.9 ppg and 54.8%, respectively, set last season by her sister Amanda Franklin.
