Statement from Jay Scott

I dispute the findings set forth in this document from top to bottom. These so-called findings and recommendations have nothing to do with the duty of a grand jury. These findings are made without ever interviewing me or requesting my testimony at a grand jury, or that of anyone who would refute the testimony of disgruntled, former employees or those motivated by politics, despite my offer of full cooperation from the beginning. Case law definitively establishes that there was no criminal conduct by me or anyone else in our office, but we were not given the opportunity to present it. This is nothing more than a vindictive swipe at our office and me after the grand jury refused to return a bill of indictment. We will issue a written response.
