

# Festival Tram & Bus Route Information

## 1. C.H. Moore Homestead DeWitt County Museum

The original home of the Apple 'N Pork Festival, the museum and grounds include tours of the historic C.H. Moore house, over 25 food booths offering old-fashioned favorites, an art show on the east lawn, numerous crafters demonstrating and offering their wares for sale, tractor show, farm museum, meal grinding and rope making demonstrations, musical entertainment and much more. Cross the red covered bridge to the fairground flea market featuring more than 200 booths offering an array of merchandise.

## 2. Vespasian Warner Public Library

Craft fair sponsored by the Vespasian Warner Public Library. Many vendors and exhibitors will display their exceptional talents.

## 3. Country Junction / Rt. 51 & 54

Country Junction features room design settings offering a blend of antiques, vintage finds, furniture, fashion, gifts and home decor. \*\*Over 200 outdoor vendors on this site in cooperation with Clinton Antique Mall\*\*

## 4. Clinton Antique Mall / Rt. 51 & 54

Over 100 permanent booths and showcases overflowing with quality antiques and collectibles. Huge collection of glass, coins, trunks, toys, crocks, graniteware and collectibles. \*\*200 vendors outdoors on this site. Food, drink and parking available. Port-a-potties on site.
