

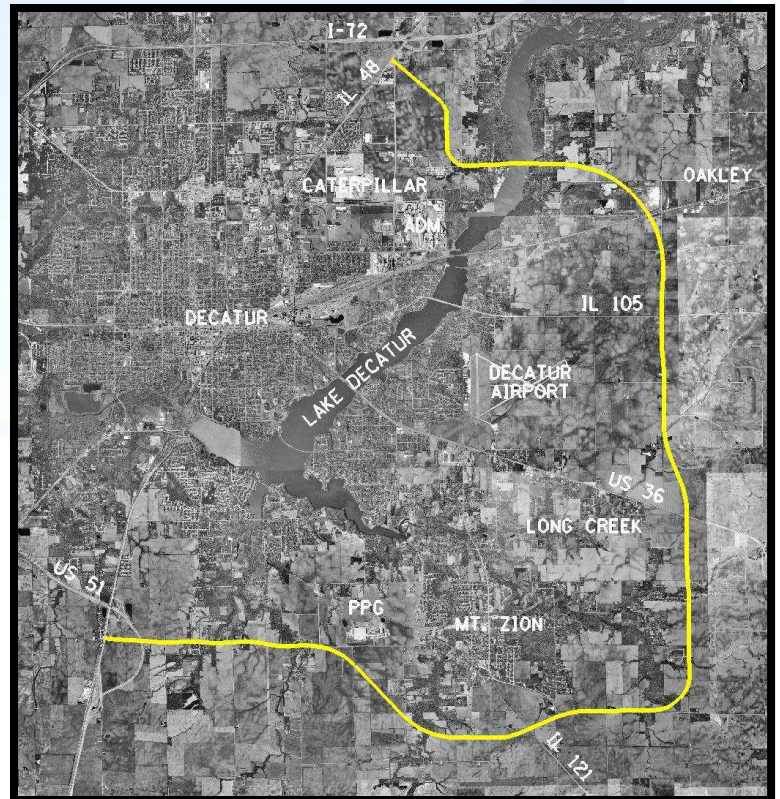
Macon County Beltway Fact Sheet

Purpose and Need

A Beltway around the south and east sides of the Decatur area is needed to

- improve access and capacity for passenger and freight movement through the southern and eastern parts of the community
- provide system continuity between U.S. Route 51, Illinois Route 121, U.S. Route 36, Illinois Route 105, Illinois Route 48 and Interstate 72
- support and promote economic growth and competitiveness
- allow for the future expansion of the Decatur Airport
- enhance and coordinate the planning of land use while shaping the form of development in the project area for years to come.
