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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

Item Number	Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below.
	Investigation to complaints F-4194 (received 5/25/2021) and F-4198 (received 6/7/2021).
	F-4194: Caller stated on 5/17/21 observing cockroaches on bar counter and crawling up the wall in the kitchen.
	During investigation, observed live cockroaches and evidence of rodent activity (droppings/chewed equipment). Observed live cockroaches in the following areas:
	1. Cockroach activity (light) observed in bar area near counter service
	2. Cockroach activity (light) bag-in-box storage rack and CO2 tank storage
	3. Cockroach activity (moderate) observed behind reach in freezer, under hot wells, on floor/walls, behind reach in coolers (3). Observed dead cockroach on food contact surface (cutting board). Observations were in cookline.
	4. Cockroach activity (heavy) observed on floor/base board behind pizza oven and stove. Heavy cockroach activity also observed in cracks of baseboards and damaged walls (FRP) in the pizza production station. Heavy cockroach activity observed on wheels/casters and motor housing of the production line reach in cooler. Observed cockroach activity in pizza boxes.
	5. Cockroach activity (heavy) observed in dish room behind damaged walls (FRP), in cracks of baseboards, and on floor under dish machine. Observed cockroach activity in storage bin where clean equipment was stored (droppings and egg casings).
	6. Cockroach activity (light) observed on floor and wall under three compartment sink.
	7. Cockroach activity (light) observed in dough prep area on floors and shelves near active food prep.
	8. Observed signs of rodent activity (mice) in gaming area, electrical utility closet, wait station, dough prep room (droppings).

Item Number	Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below.	
	Due to infestation of live cockroaches and evidence of rodent activity in multiple locations, observations have been deemed an imminent health hazard and facility is closed. (F-4194 founded)	
	The following steps are required prior to reopening: 1. Create an effective pest management plan to eliminate cockroaches and rodents. 2. Increase sanitation measures and make necessary repairs to damaged walls/baseboards to exclude pests 3. Submit in writing, a corrective action plan stating steps taken to correct imminent health hazard and prevent future infestations 4. Submit payment of \$250 (fine for reinspection) * CAP * 5. Once corrective action plan and fine are submitted to Macon County Health Department, plan will be reviewed for approval. 6. Once all steps are completed, contact Macon County Health Department for reinspection	
	F-4198: caller stated after closing on 6/6/21, employees used "bug bombs" in facility. The use of pesticides in a commercial facility is restricted and only to be applied by a licensed pest control operator. Failure to apply correctly may result in chemical cross-contamination of food / food contact surfaces. Employee confirmed that bug bombs were utilized by a non-licensed pest operator. Prior to reopening due to potential risk of cross contamination, all exposed / uncovered food (frier oil) must be discarded. All food and non-food contacted surfaces must be cleaned and sanitized. Improper use of a toxic substance is deemed an imminent health hazard. (F-4198 founded)

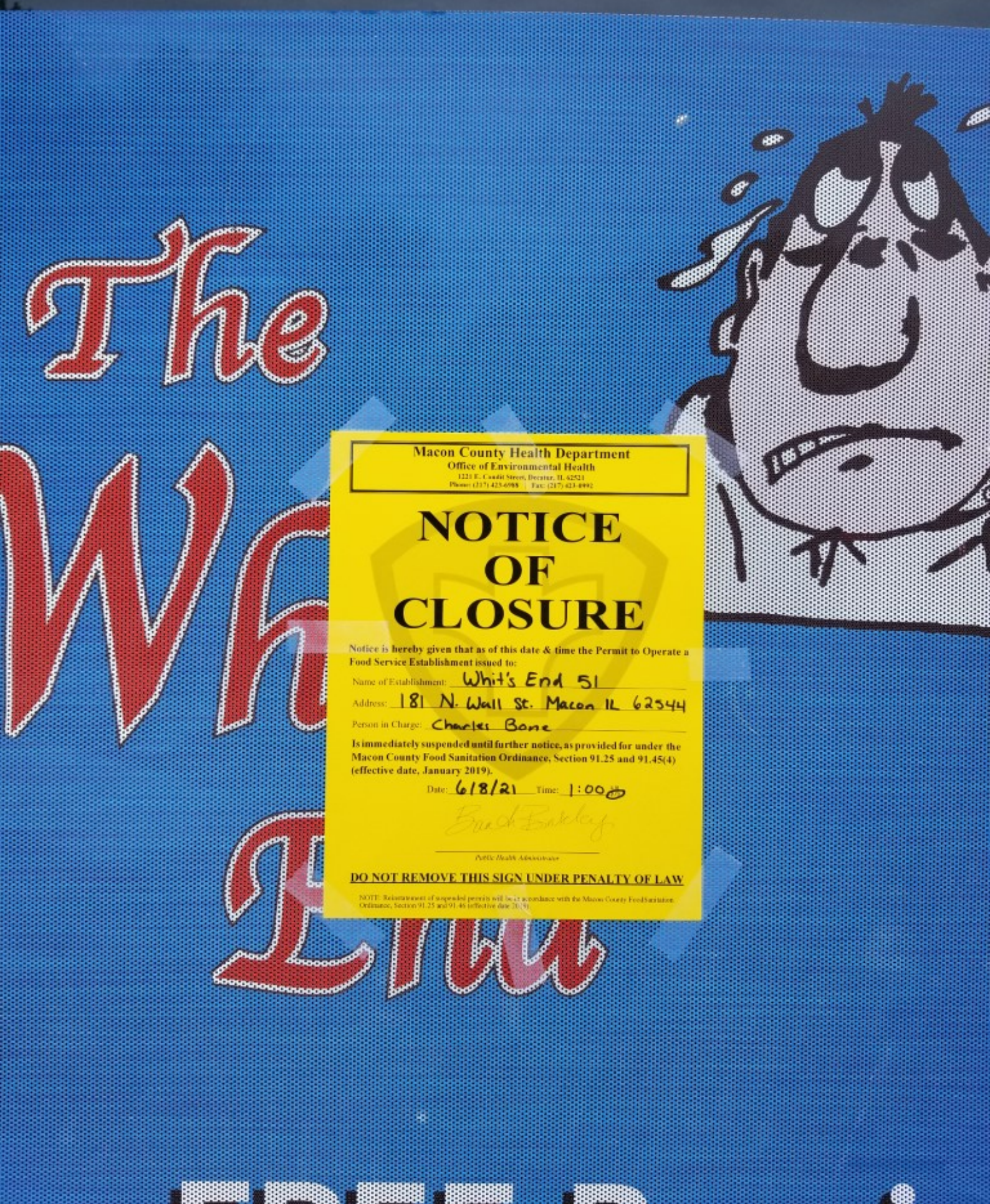
