Approval of this measure will create a new taxing district to support the operations and maintenance of Midland Community Park. The new district will have a permanent tax rate limit of \$0.25 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. This funding will ensure the district can obtain liability insurance, maintain membership in the Special Districts Association of Oregon, and sustain park operations. A map and legal description of the proposed district boundaries are included in election materials. This measure is contingent on voter approval of the dissolution of the existing park district. A home assessed at \$100,000.00 would pay approximately \$25.00 per year. 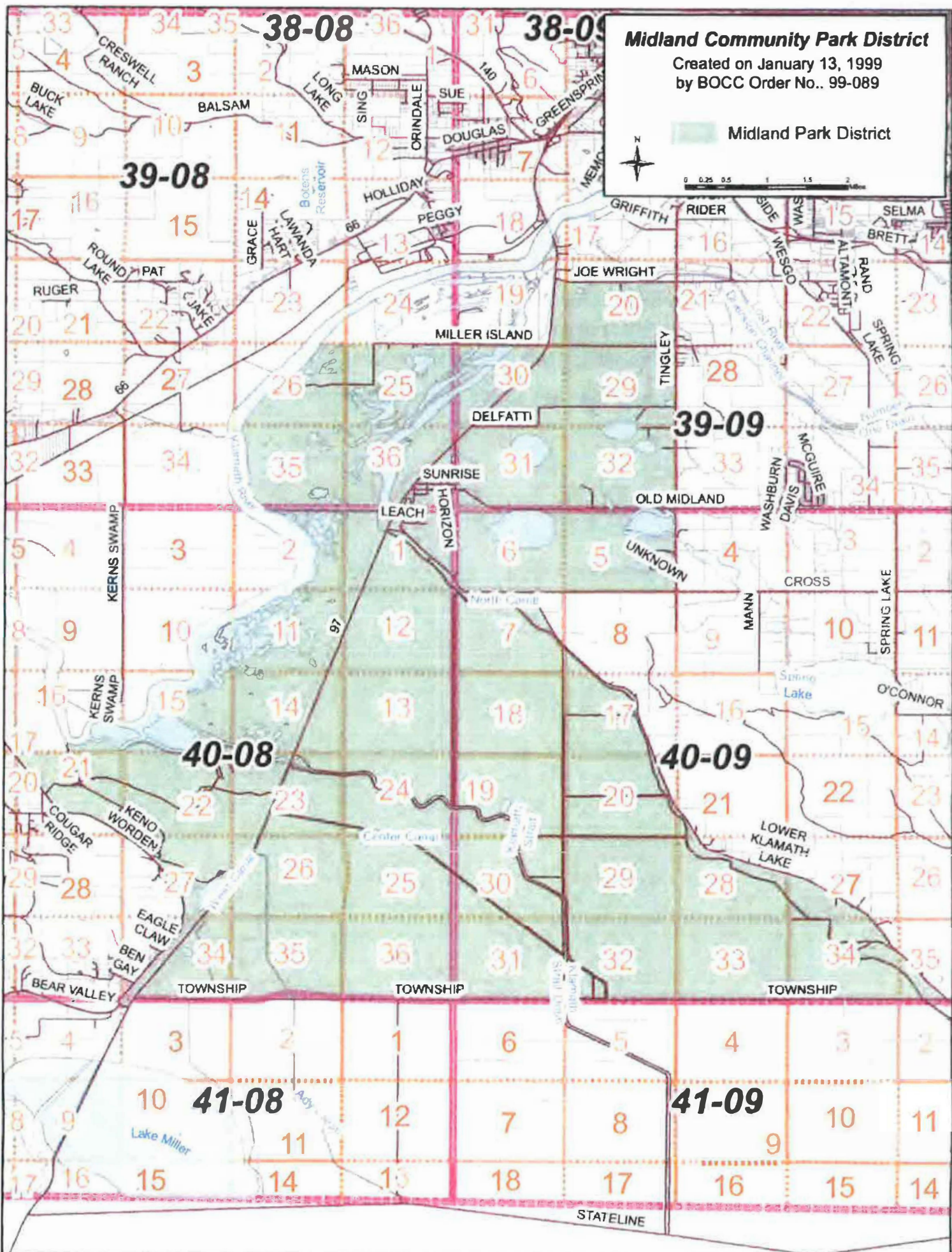

EXHIBIT A

MIDLAND COMMUNITY PARK DISTRICT
BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

A parcel of land, situated in Township 39 South, Ranges 8 & 9 East and Township 40 South, Ranges 8 & 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline intersection of Joe Wright Road and Tingley Lane; thence south along the centerline of said Tingley Lane to the centerline intersection of Cross Road; thence west along the centerline of said Cross Road to the centerline intersection of Lower Klamath Lake Road; thence southeasterly along the centerline of said Lower Klamath Lake Road to the centerline intersection of Township Road; thence west along the centerline of said Township Road to the centerline intersection of State Highway #97; thence southwesterly along the centerline of said State Highway #97 to the centerline intersection of Keno Wordon Road; thence northwesterly along the centerline of said Keno Wordon Road to the west line of Section 21, Township 40 South, Range 8 East; thence north along the west line of said Section 21 to the section corner common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, Township 40 South, Range 8 East; thence east along the south line of said Section 16 to the Southeast corner of Government Lot 3 of said Section 16; thence northwesterly along the east line of said Government Lot 3 to the west bank of the Klamath River; thence east to the centerline of said Klamath River; thence northeasterly along the centerline of said Klamath River to the north line of Section 26, Township 39 South, Range 8 East; thence east along the north line of Sections 26 and 25, Township 39 South, Range 8 East and Section 30 Township 39 South, Range 9 East, also being along the centerline of a portion of Miller Island Road, to the centerline intersection of State Highway #97; thence northerly along the centerline of said State Highway #97 to the centerline intersection of Joe Wright Road; thence easterly along the centerline of said Joe Wright road to the point of beginning.
