Question (20):

Should a Board be created to study state border relocation benefits for Klamath county citizens?

Summary (175):

Approval of this measure would mandate that the Chief Deputy Clerk of the County appoint three members to a Border Relocation Board that would meet three times annually to study and evaluate, then report, on the potential benefits of any border relocations between states, specifically Oregon and Idaho. The Board would meet three times a year. They would serve one year. They would serve without compensation.

In accordance with ORS 250.168(2), the proposed initiative meets the requirements of Section 1 (2)(d), Article IV and Section 10, Article VI of the Oregon Constitution.

Also, in accordance with ORS 250.175(5) and ORS 250.195, notice is hereby given that any elector may file a petition for review of the ballot title in the Klamath County Circuit Court no later than the seventh business day after the title was filed with the county clerk and notify the local elections official. Last day to file a petition for review and notify Klamath County Clerk is Friday, June 5, 2020, 5:00 p.m.
