Celebrate LABOR DAY!

Sept. 2, 2019, is the 125th anniversary of the national holiday of Labor Day. President Grover Cleveland signed it into law in 1894.

Beginning in the late 19th century, members of trade unions and labor movements proposed that a day be set aside to celebrate labor. The first known celebration was

on Sept. 5, 1882, in New York City, organized by groups comprising the Central Labor Union.

The day is meant to commemorate the contributions workers in the United States have made to the nation, helping to make it one of the strongest and most prosperous countries in the world.
