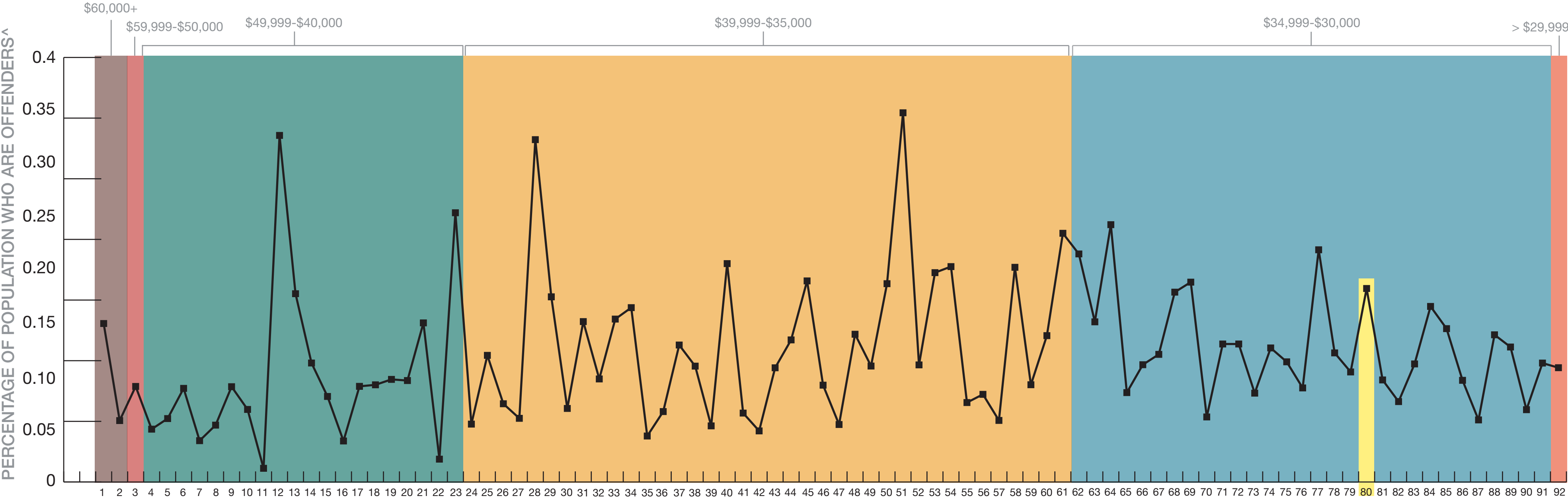


IS THERE A CORRELATION BETWEEN A COUNTY'S PER CAPITA INCOME AND THE PERCENTAGE OF A COUNTY'S POPULATION WHO ARE OFFENDERS CONVICTED OF SEX CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN?

While anecdotal evidence might suggest that counties with higher per capita incomes have a smaller percentage of offenders, a comparison of the incomes and percentage of the population that are sex offenders convicted of crimes against children in Indiana's 92 counties shows no direct correlation between a county's per capita income and its percentage of convicted offenders.
