# WELCOME TO THE 10TH ANNUAL COASTLINE CHILDREN'S FILM FESTIVAL

Ten years ago (!) we were inspired by the **8½ FOUNDATION** (eightandahalf.org) — founded by Tilda Swinton and Mark Cousins — and its mission to make great films available to young people everywhere:

"And we have noticed over the many hundred cinema journeys we have taken that our most memorable maybe made many decades ago, maybe made without color, maybe with subtitles, or not a single spoken word."

That idea became our mandate; our manifesto. For 10 days, we invite you to enjoy a selection of full-length features, documentaries, short films and classic silent films!

The festival kicks off **FRIDAY MARCH 13TH** with an **OPENING NIGHT COSTUME PARTY** at Krasl Art Center. Come as your favorite animated character and you could win a prize for most creative costume. Festivities begin at 6:00 pm with popcorn, cupcakes from **BIT OF SWISS**, a costume art activity and music by **BRANDON MATTSON** and his ukulele students from Watervliet Elementary. KID FLICKS ONE, a selection of animated and live action shorts from the New York International Children's Film Festival (NYICFF), begins at 7:00 PM.

The **YOUNG FILMMAKERS COMPETITION** will premiere at New Buffalo Township Library (New Buffalo, MI) on **SATURDAY MARCH 14TH**. This year's competition challenge – JUST ADD WATER – features 8 short films by young visionaries from Michigan and Indiana. Awards will be presented, red carpet style on **FRIDAY MARCH 20TH** – immediately following the 5:30 PM program screening at Citadel Oak Room.

Other events include a **POST-SCREENING CONVERSATION** with (and short film about) Eileen Cropley, founder of the Citadel Dance Company (Benton Harbor) following the documentary film, DANCEMAKER, an **ART ACTIVITY** at the Benton Harbor Public Library based on the short series, RONJA: THE ROBBER'S DAUGHTER (E1 & E2) and a music and filmmaking workshop before **RIGHT IN THE EYE** — a live performance to the silent shorts of French filmmaker Georges Méliès by **ALCOLÉA & CIE**.

Finally, the inimitable **DR. LARRY SCHANKER** will provide piano accompaniment for 3 silent films — including Buster Keaton's ONF WFFK and GO WFST which close the festival at Krasl Art Center on **SUNDAY MARCH 22ND**.

Under the cover of darkness a small boy, Maki, loosens the shackles that bind him and escapes into the desert night. Pursued by slavers across the moon-lit savannah, Maki meets Zarafa, a baby giraffe – an orphan, just like him – as well as the nomad Hassan, Prince of the Desert. Hassan takes them to Alexandria for an audience with the Pasha of Egypt, who orders him to deliver the exotic animal as a gift to King Charles of France. And so Maki, Zarafa and Hassan take off in a hot-air balloon to cross the Mediterranean, setting off an adventure across Northern Africa, the bustling port of Marseilles, and over the snow-capped peaks of the Alps, arriving at last in Paris. But all the while, Maki is determined to find a way to return Zarafa to her rightful home.

#### ROCCA CHANGES THE WORLD GERMAN

Brave, funny, and one of a kind: that's Rocca. Rocca is 11 years old and lives a rather unique life. While her dad is watching over her as an astronaut from outer space, Rocca lives alone with her pet squirrel. While attending a normal school for the first time in her life, Rocca's carefree and non-conformist way of life instantly stands out. She fearlessly confronts the class bullies and befriends a homeless man. With neverending optimism, Rocca proves that, together with her new friends, a child has the power to change the world.

The endearing saga of the March sisters — Meg (Frances Dee), Jo (Katharine Hepburn), Amy (Joan Bennett) and Beth (Jean Parker) — who come of age in New England during the Civil War, is based on the classic Louisa May Alcott novel. With Mr. March away fighting for the Union cause, the girls and their beloved mother, Marmee manage to keep their spirits up through dire economic and emotional crises, until Jo's literary aspirations and Meg's romance with a teacher threaten to pull the sisters apart.

#### THE SPIRIT OF THE BEEHIVE SPAIN

In a small Castilian village in 1940, in the wake of the country's devastating civil war, six-year-old Ana attends a traveling movie show of Frankenstein and becomes possessed by the memory of it. Produced as Franco's long regime was nearing its end, *The Spirit of the Beehive* (widely regarded as the greatest Spanish film of the 1970s) is a bewitching portrait of a child's haunted inner life and one of the most visually arresting movies ever made.

Prequel to the 2004 coming-of-age, live-action film *Hana & Alice*. After her parents separate, 14 year-old Tetsuko (who will soon be nick-named Alice) moves with her mother to a new town and must enroll as a transfer student at Ishinomori Middle School. She immediately finds herself bullied upon being assigned the seat of "Judas" who is rumored to have been murdered over a year before. If anybody knows his fate it's Hana, the reclusive girl living next door in a house that everyone is afraid of. Together, they set off to solve the 'smallest murder in the world'.

#### ALICE IN WONDERLAND III

Experience the classic tale of Alice in Wonderland as never before in this live-action adaptation from the BBC. The story of the last Seal Child's journey home. After their mother's disappearance, Ben and Saoirse are sent to live with Granny in the city. When they resolve to return to their home by the sea, their journey becomes a race against time as they are drawn into a world Ben knows only from his mother's folktales. But this is no bedtime story; these fairy folk have been in our world far too long. It soon becomes clear to Ben that Saoirse is the key to their survival.

#### SING STREET IRFLAND



Welcome to 1980s Dublin seen through the eyes of a 14-year-old boy named Conor who is looking for a break from a home strained by his parents' relationship and money troubles while trying to adjust to his new inner-city public school (where kids are rough and the teachers are rougher). He finds a glimmer of hope in the mysterious, über-cool and beautiful Raphina. With the aim of winning her heart, he invites her to star in his band's music videos. There's only one problem: he doesn't have a band (yet). Raphina agrees and now Conor must deliver. Calling himself "Cosmo" and immersing himself in the vibrant rock music trends of the decade, he forms a band with a few lads and shows how music has the power to take us away from the turmoil of everyday life and transform us into something greater.

From the moment he straps on his Walkman headphones and drinks in the tightrope of ecstasy and despair that is "Dancing in the Dark" (the lyrics swirling around him on screen), he's more than just a born-again Bruce fan – Springsteen's music becomes his fixation, his obsession, his identity and his runaway American dream. Javed just about syncs his heartbeat to the legendary icon's sound and it gives him the courage to do the things he never would have dared to do otherwise.

Marona is a mixed-breed Labrador whose life leaves deep traces among the humans she encounters. After an accident, she reflects on all the homes and different experiences she's had. As Marona's memory journeys into the past, her unfailing empathy and love brings lightness and innocence into each of her owners' lives. A beautiful and deeply emotional story of an average dog and her extraordinary life.

#### DANCEMAKER IISA

DRAWN TOGETHER: COMICS. DIVERSITY & STEREOTYPES USA



The tale of the extraordinary, peculiarly-American phenomenon—the Paul Taylor Dance Company. Hailed as the world's greatest living choreographer, Taylor's life is traced from solitary child to star dancer to master choreographer. Interviews with current and past members of the company offer glimpses of the pain, joy, obsession and love that motivate these artists. The film travels with the company from rehearsal studio, to an embassy-sponsored tour of India, through a strike-threatened Broadway season, finally concentrating on Taylor's struggle to make a new dance that will be the centerpiece of his company's season.

A panel discussion with Eileen Cropley, former Taylor dancer and founder of Citadel Dance Company in Benton Harbor follows the film. We've enlisted Caroline Spikner, a Southwest Michigan native, to document the history of Ms. Cropley. This nearly hour-long feature highlights stories from comic creators whose work pushes the envelope in a popular medium that, for its entire history in the United States, has been dominated by white male writers, illustrators and industry executives. Vishavjit Singh (more popularly known as Sikh Captain America) is a New York based animator and performance artist. **Eileen Kaur Alden** is co-creator of Super Sikh, a superhero who fights oppression both domestic (misogynists at night clubs) and international (a Taliban crew trying to keep women and girls out of school). **Keith Knight** is an independent artist-educator who makes comic strips, many of them about race and police brutality, that have appeared in many publications including Colorlines.

#### **EVERYBODY KNOWS ELIZABETH MURRAY**



This intimate portrait of maverick painter and printmaker **Elizabeth Murray** explores the relationship between her family life and career while considering her place in contemporary art history. Excerpts from her journals voiced by Meryl Streep, verité footage and home videos show Murray's internal struggles and incredible ambition. Exclusive interviews with art world luminaries describe the thriving New York art scene within which Murray challenged and captivated her viewers. In 2005, Murray was the fifth woman to be celebrated with a retrospective at the Museum of Modern Art. Breaking convention, Murray's paintings still defy efforts at categorization. Through them she made an indelible imprint on the contemporary art world. This film chronicles her remarkable journey from an impoverished childhood in Chicago to the extraordinary art world of lower Manhattan, before she lost her life to cancer in 2007.

#### AÏLO: A LAPLAND ODYSSEY FRANCE




From the heights of the Arctic poles to the bottom of the temperature scale, Aïlo and its panoramic Lapland landscape captivate with cinematic splendor. Follow a young reindeer's first year at close range, filled with moments of puzzlement, wonder, struggle and delight as Aïlo, guided by his mother, naviagates an icy world. Sharing the terrain with Aïlo (and subtly directed to 'act') are a hilariously and ever-wiggly stoat, sharpeyed wolves and an endlessly-curious red-eared squirrel (included as a humorous reference to the animated feature *Ice Age*) in this snowy story fashioned through witty narration and clever cross-cutting.



#### MODERN TIMES IISA



Modern Times, Charlie Chaplin's final outing as the Little Tramp, puts the iconic character to work as a giddily inept factory employee who becomes smitten with a gorgeous street urchin. With its barrage of unforgettable gags and sly commentary on class struggle during the Great Depression, Modern Times-though made almost a decade into the talkie era and containing moments of sound (even song!)—is a timeless showcase of Chaplin's untouchable genius as a director of silent comedy.

#### RIGHT IN THE EYE — SILENT FILM SCREENING & PERFORMANCE

MOVIF CONCERT BASED ON THE CINEMATOGRAPHIC WORKS OF GEORGES MÉLIÈS | ALCOLÉA & CIE | 75 MINUTES | AGES 7+

If fanciful mental constructs and abstract concepts were to become personified, it would be no surprise if they took the form of Georges Méliès. Considered the inventor of cinema by the Lumière brothers, Méliès is someone best defined by superlatives. It took just a few years for this pioneer and entertainer to reveal the full extent of his visionary genius before ending his life in poverty, entirely forgotten.

Drawing inspiration from the fictional fantasy worlds of such features as Le voyage à travers l'impossible (The Impossible Voyage or the burlesque universe of shorts like Un homme de têtes (The Four Troublesome Heads), this movie concert (with its 11 original compositions — one for each film) presents a modern interpretation of the playful universe of Georges Méliès.

The show's lighting was designed to reflect the atmosphere and color temperatures of the films. The stage set was inspired by Méliès' productions and brings continuity to the projection.

ALCOLÉA & CIE is a reactive and creative team comprising artists, visual artists and technicians working together to produce each show. The company presents multidisciplinary productions for the general public and productions for young audiences.

**Jean-François Alcoléa** is a piano player, composer, improviser and stage designer whose shows reflect his singular world through a combination of music, sound effects and visuals.

SILENT FILM | BUSTER KEATON | 1920 | 25 MINUTES | AGES 6+



In this first Buster Keaton-directed film to be released to the public (and one of the top grossing movies of 1920), Keaton and his new bride (Sybil Seely) are given a portable, build-it-yourself house as a wedding gift. However, unbeknownst to the couple, the wife's jealous ex-boyfriend changes the lables on the crates containing the building materials. Following the printed instructions, Keaton proceeds to build (and finish) the house in one week (as the plans promise) and what a house it is!

Buster Keaton is Friendless, a bumbling Midwesterner who finds work as a cowpuncher when he wanders into the Diamond Bar Ranch after falling off a freight train out of New York City and landing in the middle of the Arizona desert. His complete lack of experience makes him the laughing stock of the ranch. When his only friend – a cow named Brown Eyes – is sent to the slaughterhouse, Friendless sets out to rescue her and winds up driving the entire Diamond Bar herd through the streets of Los Angeles!


#### RONJA. THE ROBBER'S DAUGHTER: THE COMPLETE SERIES

Ronja, the only child of a bandit chief, grows up among a clan of robbers living in a castle in the woodlands of early-Medieval Scandinavia. 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
