BY AMENDING SECTION 11.70 SUBD. 28. REGARDING SIGN REGULATIONS AND BY ADOPT-ING BY REFERENCE EAGAN CITY CODE CHAPTER 1 AND SECTION 11.99.

The City Council of the City of Eagan does ordain: Section 1. Chapter 11 of the Eagan City Code is hereby amended by revising Section 11.70, Subd. 28(E)(10) to read as follows: 10. Temporary signs for special

business sales. Any commercial use may have up to three signs for the purpose of promoting a special sales event, provided the signs may not be displayed for no more than fourteen (14) days within a 60-day period. The 60-day period shall commence on the first day of posting a temporary sign and conclude

60 days thereafter. The temporary signs shall not exceed an aggregate total area of 100 square feet. The sign permit application shall

specify the days, not to exceed fourteen, which the temporary sign will be displayed. Section 2. Eagan City Code Chapter 1 entitled "General Provisions and Definitions Applicable

to the Entire City Code Including 'Penalty for Violation'" and Section 11.99, entitled "Violation a Misdemeanor" are hereby adopted in their entirety by reference as though repeated verbatim. Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon its

adoption and publication according
