

CITY OF WYOMING GREENWOOD AT CARLOS AVERY, DRAFT EAW IS AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT

The City of Wyoming is pleased to provide a copy of the DRAFT EAW Document for the Greenwood at Carlos Avery Project for the 30 day review and comment period.

The proposed Greenwood at Carlos Avery Project would entail the development of approximately 193 acres within the City of Wyoming, MN. The project proposes the development of 300 single-family units, 100 multi-family units, and 50 acres of commercial uses on the former Greenwood Golf Links golf course site. The north western part of the site is bordered by the Carlos Avery State Wildlife Management Area.

By State statute, this level of development requires a mandatory Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW). Copies of the Draft EAW have been distributed to agencies listed on the most current Minnesota Environmental Quality Board distribution list.

The DRAFT EAW will be distributed to the June 2018 distribution list hosted by the EQB. Published notice of this EAW will occur on the EQB Monitor on Monday, February 11th, 2019, and all comments will be due by the end of Wednesday, March 13th, 2019.

The DRAFT EAW may be accessed electronically on the City of Wyoming's website; paper copies are available for review at the City Hall, 26885 Forest Boulevard, and at the Minneapolis Central Branch of the Hennepin County Public Library (300 Nicollet Mall, Minneapolis).
