ORDINANCE #2018 - 05
AN ORDINANCE
REPLACING CHAPTERS
X AND XI OF THE
CRYSTAL CITY CODE
SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE
NO. 2018-05**

Ordinance No. 2018-05 has been approved by the city council on Oct. 16, 2018. A printed copy of the full text of the ordinance is available for public inspection in the office of the city clerk and is available on the city's website.

The ordinance replaces Chapters X and XI of the Crystal City Code. Chapter X contains the general regulations and requirements associated with all business licensing and permits, and the new provisions clarify and make said regulations and requirements easier to read. Additionally, Chapter X now has a reference chart containing the various businesses subject to city licensing. Chapter XI contains the regulations applicable to specific business types, including consumer fireworks, tobacco, peddlers/solicitors, tree trimming, secondhand goods dealers, pawnbrokers, lawful gambling, adult establishments, and therapeutic massage. A number of other business types were removed and will no longer be licensed by the city. The revisions to Chapter XI clarify the specific business regulations by using a more uniform format throughout. Specific penalties for violations were removed and will be inserted into appendix IV. The ordinance is effective 30 days after publication.
