D/B/A MILLE LACS RESORT & MARINA; EQUITY-BRIDGE FUND, LLC; WAYNE LEE; JUDD MACKINNON; UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY, INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE; STATE OF MINNESOTA, COMMISSIONER OF REVENUE; AND ALL OTHER PERSONS OR PARTIES UNKNOWN CLAIMING ANY RIGHT, TITLE, ESTATE, INTEREST OR LIEN UPON THE REAL ESTATE LISTED IN THE CAPTION

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that you, and all persons interested, appear before this Court on June 11, 2018 at 10:00 a.m., at the Mille Lacs County Justice Center, Milaca, Minnesota, and then or as soon thereafter as said matter can be heard, show cause, if any there be, why this Court should not enter an Order as follows:

That the Registrar of Titles, upon the filing with her of a certified copy of this Order, cancel Certificate of Title No. 6694, and enter a new Certificate of Title for the land therein described in favor of Francis Jay Buysse and Michael Joseph Buysse, as Co-Personal Representatives of the Estate of Francis Joseph Buysse, 6712-156th Avenue SE, Bellevue, WA 98006, subject to the memorials of Document Nos. 251,389,472,509 a/k/a Document No. 196271 and 1259.5, but free from all other memorials now appearing on the present Certificate of Title, the last of which is Document No. 17720, and free also from the memorial of this Order. The face of the Certificate of Title should state: "The State of Minnesota has reserved in trust for the taxing districts concerned all minerals and mineral rights."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this Order be served as follows:

1. At least 10 days before the hearing upon the above-named parties, (except USA) residing in this State in the manner provided by law for the service of the Summons in a civil action;

2. At least 14 days before the hearing upon each of the above-named nonresidents by sending a copy of this Order to the non-resident's post office address, by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested;

3. Upon each of the above-named parties who cannot be found by two weeks published notice and by sending a copy of this Order at least 14 days before the hearing by first class mail to the last known address of the party and by sending another copy of this Order at least 14 days before the hearing by first class mail to the address of such party as stated on the Certificate of Title, if an address is so stated;

4. Upon a dissolved, withdrawn, or revoked business entity governed by Minn. Stat. Chp. 302A, 303,317A, 322A, 322B, or 323 in the manner provided by Minn. Stat. § 5.25; and

5. Per Title 28 USC § 2410, and Federal Rules of Procedure, Rule 4, the United States Government must be notified at least sixty (60) days prior to the hearing in the manner provided by law for the service of the Summons in a civil action.
