28, 2024. The purpose of this ordinance is

to establish a Local Housing Trust Fund and designate the Columbia Heights Economic Development Authority (EDA) as the administrator of the fund. The Local Housing

Trust Fund aims to support the rehabilitation and preservation of existing affordable housing and promote the development of additional affordable housing within the City. The funds will be used to develop or preserve affordable

housing for persons with incomes not exceeding 115% of the median family income for Minnesota. Allowable uses include administrative expenses (up to 10% of the fund balance), grants, loans, loan guarantees, matching other funds, and providing down payment as-

sistance, rental assistance, and

home buyer counseling services. The EDA will administer the fund, determine the terms and conditions for financial assistance, and report annually to the City Council on fund usage. The annual report will be posted on the City's website. This is a summary of Ordinance
