That the Registrar of Titles of Washington County, upon the filing of a certified copy of this Order, Court File No. 82-CV-18-1195, cancel Certificate of Title No. 57984 and enter a new certificate for the land therein described in favor of U.S. Bank National Association, as Trustee for Harborview Mortgage Loan Trust 2005-2, Mortgage Loan Pass-Through Certificates, Series 2005-2, free of all the memorials now appearing on said certificate up to and including Document No. 1252679 and free of the memorial of this Order.

Attendance is required only by those who wish to object to the entry of the above-described order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order be served: (a) at least 10 days prior to such hearing upon all of the above named parties residing in this State in the manner provided by law for the service of a Summons in a Civil action; (b) at least 14 days prior to such hearing upon any of the above named parties not residing in this State by sending a copy of this Order by registered or certified mail, return receipt, to each of such parties at his/her post office address; (c) upon any of the above named parties who cannot be found by two weeks published notice and at least 14 days prior to the hearing by sending a copy of this Order by First Class mail to each of such parties at his/her last known address and at his/her address as stated on the Certificate of Titles if his/her address is so stated.

(d) upon a dissolved, withdrawn, or revoked business entity governed by Minn. Stat., Chp. 302A, 303, 317A, 322A, 322B, or 323 in the manner provided by Minn. Stat. §5.25. (Note: return date on Order to Show Cause must be at least 30 days after date of mailing by the Secretary of State.)
