The City Council of Brooklyn Park has determined that pursuant to its City Code, Ordinance #2024-1307 be published in summary form.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE #2024-1307

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 127 ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR REGISTRATION OF CANNABIS AND HEMP BUSINESSES AND RELATED REGULATIONS AND AMENDING CHAPTER 152 OF THE BROOKLYN PARK CITY CODE CREATING ZONING REGULATIONS FOR CANNABIS BUSINESSES

Ordinance #2024-1307 amends Title XI of the City Code by adding Chapter 127, as well as amending Chapter 152 pertaining to cannabis regulation. The ordinance establishes parameters for which cannabis-oriented businesses may operate within the City of Brooklyn Park. The ordinance identifies the process for registering cannabis retail businesses, as well as land use regulation for all cannabis businesses. The effective date of the ordinance is 30 days after its publishing in the City's official newspaper.

This summary of Ordinance #2024-1307 has been approved by the City Council on December 9, 2024. A printed copy of the full text of the ordinance is available for public inspection in the office of the city clerk.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its publication.
