NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Princeton, Minnesota (the "City"), will meet on August 23, 2018 at 7:00 P.M., at the City Hall, 705 Second Street North, in Princeton, Minnesota, for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on a proposal that the City of Minneapolis, Minnesota (the "Issuer") issue its revenue bonds (the "Revenue Bonds"), in one or more series, under Minnesota Statutes, Sections 469.152 through 469.165, as amended, on behalf of Fairview Health Services, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation ("Fairview"), in order to, among other purposes, refund the Issuer's Health Care System Revenue Bonds, Series 2008B (Fairview Health Services), its Health Care System Variable Rate Demand Revenue Bonds, Series 2008C (Fairview Health Services), its Health Care System Variable Rate Demand Revenue Bonds, Series 2008D (Fairview Health Services) and its Health Care System Variable Rate Demand Revenue Bonds, Series 2008E (Fairview Health Services) (together, the "Refunded Bonds"), a portion of which were used to finance and refinance the construction and improvement of Fairview Northland Medical Center and other health care-related facilities located at 911 Northland Drive in the City (the "Princeton Facilities"). The Princeton Facilities are owned and operated by Fairview. The Revenue Bonds will not be issued by the City.

The Revenue Bonds will be issued as part of a larger bond issue by the Issuer in an aggregate amount which is not expected to exceed \$550,000,000, the proceeds of which will be used to finance or refinance the acquisition, construction, renovation, expansion, remodeling and equipping by Fairview or its affiliates of health care facilities located in the cities of Minneapolis, Burnsville, Chisago City, Edina, Hibbing and Wyoming, Minnesota, in addition to the City.

All persons interested may appear and be heard at the time and place set forth above, or may file written comments with the City Clerk prior to the date of the hearing set forth above.
