GENERAL NOTICE
TO DESTROY WEEDS
YOU ARE REQUIRED TO
DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS
ON YOUR PROPERTY**

Notice is hereby given this 3rd day of May 2018 pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Sec. 18.78, all owners, occupants, agents and public officials in charge of land in Richfield, Minnesota, that noxious weeds are standing, being or growing on such land shall be destroyed or eradicated by effective cutting, tillage, cropping, pasturing, or treating with chemicals or other effective methods or combination thereof, approved by your weed inspector, as often as may be required to prevent weeds from blooming and maturing seeds, or spreading by roots, root stocks or other means.

Upon failure to observe this notice, the local weed inspector is required to proceed pursuant to the law and have weeds destroyed by such methods as they find necessary. The expenses of which shall constitute a lien and be entered as a tax against the land, and be collected as other real estate taxes are collected or by other means as provided by law. In all cases said published notice shall be deemed legal and sufficient notice.
