By order of this court, you are hereby cited to appear before the judge presiding in Department 12 of this court on April 24, 2019 , at 8:30 a.m. then and there to show cause, if any you have, why Nevaeh Leeann Virene Chapman should not be declared free from your custody and control for the purpose of freeing Nevaeh Leeann Virene Chapman for adoption by Cheyenne Chapman. The following information concerns rights and procedures that relate to this proceeding for the termination of custody and control of said minor as set forth in Family Code Section 7860 et seq.:

1. At the beginning of the proceeding the court will consider whether or not the interests of the minor child require the appointment of counsel. If the court finds that the interest of the minor does require such protection, the court will appoint counsel to represent her, whether or not she is able to afford counsel. The minor will not be present in court unless he requests, or the court so orders.

2. If a parent of the minor appears without counsel and is unable to afford counsel, the court must appoint counsel for the parent unless the parent knowingly and intelligently waives the right to counsel. The court will not appoint the same counsel to represent both the minor the parent.

3. The court may appoint either a public defender, or private counsel. If private counsel is appointed, he or she, will receive reasonable compensation and expenses, the amount of which will be determined by the court. That amount must be paid by the real parties in interest, but not by the minor, in such proportions the court believes to be just. If, however, the court finds that any of the real parties in interest cannot afford counsel, the amount will be paid by the county.

4. The court may continue the proceeding for not more than 30 days as necessary to allow appointed counsel to become prepared.
