Requests must be accompanied by check, draft, or money order, payable to the Sherburne County Treasurer. Bids must be accompanied by a **Certified Check or Bidder's Bond** made payable to the Sherburne County Treasurer as a proposal guarantee for at least **5% of the amount of the bid.**

No bidder may withdraw their bid (which shall include the Certified Check or the Bidder's Bond) within 15 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

It is the County's intent to begin construction **February 4, 2019 for tree clearing operations and June 3, 2019 for the reconstruction of County Road 38**

The County Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.
