## NOTICE TO VOTERS STATE GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 5, 2024

### Prepare to vote

- Election Day is Tuesday, November 5, 2024
- Polling places are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Check your voter registration status and information at: [mnvotes.sos.mn.gov/voterstatuscheck/index](https://mnvotes.sos.mn.gov/voterstatuscheck/index)
  - Enter your name, birth date, and address when prompted to check your registration status
- If you are not yet registered to vote, you may register at: [mnvotes.gov/register](https://mnvotes.gov/register)
- Election results will be available starting after 8 p.m. on Election Day at: [electionresults.sos.state.mn.us](https://electionresults.sos.state.mn.us)

### Access your Sample Ballot

- Your official ballot will include the offices and names of all candidates for your precinct
- See a list of the candidate names and questions that will be on your ballot, and view a sample ballot for your precinct at: [mnvotes.gov/myballot](https://mnvotes.gov/myballot)
  - You may request to have a free copy of your sample ballot emailed to you by emailing Hennepin County Elections at: [hc.vote@hennepin.us](mailto:hc.vote@hennepin.us) or by visiting Bloomington Civic Plaza - 1800 West Old Shakopee Road

### Find your Polling Place

- Use the Minnesota Secretary of State's polling place finder by visiting: [mnvotes.gov/pollfinder](https://mnvotes.gov/pollfinder)
- After entering your address, the finder will tell you if you have an upcoming election, where to vote and show a sample ballot for your precinct.

### Voting before Election Day

- You can vote early with an absentee ballot starting September 20, 2024
- You can vote absentee by mail, in person, or from the military or abroad.
- To vote absentee by mail you can either:
  - Apply online: [mnvotes.sos.mn.gov/abrequest/index](https://mnvotes.sos.mn.gov/abrequest/index) or
  - Print and complete an absentee ballot application and return to Hennepin County Elections.
- To be counted, your ballot must be received before 8 p.m. on Election Day.
  - Mail your ballot back in the pre-paid, pre-addressed envelope that was provided with your ballot materials.
  - Drop off your ballot no later than 8 p.m. on Election Day.
- Bloomington Civic Plaza - 1800 West Old Shakopee Road
  - \*Note you cannot drop off your absentee ballot at the election day polling place.
- To vote absentee in-person:
  - Visit Bloomington Civic Plaza - 1800 West Old Shakopee Road
- September 20 - October 25: 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. (Monday- Friday)
- October 26: 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. (Saturday)
- October 29: 8 a.m. - 7 p.m. (Tuesday)
- November 2: 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. (Saturday)
- November 3: 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. (Sunday)
- November 4: 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. (Monday)
